3. Operations:

The Trustees have continued to invest the majority of the charity's funds in accounts with the CCLA (Charities, Churches and Local Authorities Investment Fund) which invests in long term multi asset investments providing sustainable growth in capital value and income.

In 2025 the Trustees made two donations to REACH (Haverhill) totalling £900 to be used exclusively in providing assistance for parishioners living in the parish of Horseheath identified as being in need of financial help. This is the third consecutive year that such a donation has been made to REACH.

The Trustees are also able to consider any other requests for assistance from individual parishioners.
